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
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
Quarter Reporting for Jan. 2015 – Mar. 2015:

- 23 Families referred , 20 Families matched
- Ethnicity of the families referred:
 - o 40% Latino (8 families)
 - \circ 40% Caucasian (8 families)
 - \circ 5% African American (1 family)
 - 15% Multiracial (3 families)
- > Age of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - \odot 25% Birth-1 year old
 - o 20% 1-2 years old
 - \circ 10% 2-3 years old
 - o 20% 3-6 years old
 - o 25% 6 years and older
- > **Primary Language** in the home:
 - English 9 families
 - Spanish 5 families
 - $\,\circ\,$ English & Spanish 3 families
 - \odot Other 1 family
- Newborn Hearing Screening results as reported by the parent:
 - \circ Did Not Pass 8 children
 - Passed 10 children
 - Pass/Did Not Pass 0 children
 - Was not screened 2 children
- Gender of children enrolled in GBYS:
 0 16 male, 4 female
- > Medical History suggestive of:
 - \circ Hereditary no children
 - \circ Condition assoc. with a hearing loss, 6 children
