
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
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- ➤ 14 Families referred, 13 Families matched Families referred may opt out of participating or may still be in the process of trying to reach them to enroll them within GBYS.
- **Ethnicity** of the families referred:
 - o 15% Caucasian (2 families)
 - o 15% Multiracial (2 families)
 - o 15% Latino (2 families)
 - o 23% African American (3 families)
 - o 23% Pacific Islander (3 families)
 - o 8% Asian American (1 family)
- > Age of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - o 31% Birth-1 year old
 - o 31% 1-2 years old
 - o 15% 2-3 years old
 - o 15% 3-6 years old
 - 8% 6 years and older
- **Primary Language** in the home:
 - English 11 families
 - English/Spanish 2 families
- Newborn Hearing Screening results as reported by the parent:
 - Did Not Pass 8 children
 - Passed 2 children
 - Was not screened 3 children
- Gender of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - o 8 male, 5 female
- ➤ **Medical History** suggestive of:
 - o Condition assoc. with a hearing loss, 2 children
 - O No known syndrome or etiology 10 children
 - Hereditary 1 child
- > Unilateral vs. Bilateral hearing loss:
 - Bilateral 10 children
 - Unilateral 2 children
 - Unknown 1 child
- > Insurance information of enrolled families:
 - Private 8 families
 - Dual insurance 2 families
 - All kids 3 families







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
