


Guide Spotlight

Comparison of ages of children enrolled in GBYS from Apr-Jun 2015 to July-Sept 2015

	<u>Apr-June</u>	July –Sept
Birth-1 year old	35%	27%
1-2 years old	6%	36%
2-3 years old	12%	10%
3-6 years old	35%	0%
6 years and older	12%	27%


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
Quarter Reporting for July 2015 – Sept 2015:

- > 13 Families referred , 11 Families matched
- **Ethnicity** of the families referred:
 - 36% Latino (4 families)
 - o 27% Caucasian (3 families)
 - o 9% African American (1 family)
 - o 19% Multiracial (2 families)
 - o 9% Pacific Islander (1 family)
- > Age of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - o 27% Birth-1 year old
 - o 36% 1-2 years old
 - o 10% 2-3 years old
 - o 0% 3-6 years old
 - o 27% 6 years and older
- **Primary Language** in the home:
 - English 4 families
 - Spanish 3 families
 - Dual (English & Other) 2 families
 - ASL 2 families
- Newborn Hearing Screening results as reported by the parent:
 - Did Not Pass 8 children
 - Passed 0 children
 - Pass/Did Not Pass 1 child
 - Was not screened 2 children
- > Gender of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - o 4 male, 7 female
- ➤ **Medical History** suggestive of:
 - Hereditary no children
 - o Condition assoc. with a hearing loss, 5 children
 - o No known syndrome or etiology 6 children
 - o Hearing loss and additional needs- 0 children
- ➤ Unilateral vs. Bilateral hearing loss:
 - Bilateral 10 children
 - Unilateral 1 child
- Insurance information of enrolled families:
 - ALL Kids 1 family
 - Medicaid –4 families
 - Private 4 families
 - Dual coverage 1 family
 - None 1 family
